**DISCLAIMER OF SCAMMERS WITH THE NAMES AISHA MUSTAPHA,
DR. GEORGE, DR. FRANCIS AND ABUBAKAR KPAKIKO**

WARNING TO THE PUBLIC

The attention of the Office of the Accountant General of the Federation has been drawn to the activities of fraudsters who are out to defraud unsuspecting retired and serving employees of Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) with a promise to facilitate the prompt payment of their salary/promotion arrears.

The fraudsters who claim to be staff of the Integrated Personnel and Payroll Information System (IPPIS) in the Office of the Accountant General of the Federation; go by the names **Aisha Mustapha (with the phone number 07038152316 , Dr. George (with the phone number 09128986504), Dr. Francis and Abubakar Kpakiko.**

In carrying out their activities, these fraudsters call retired and serving employees of Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs), with a proposal to move their promotion/salary arrears from batch "C" to batch "A" to facilitate imminent payment. They then demand that for the proposed service, the unsuspecting employee should pay an amount into this account number:

**Account Name: Abubakar Kpakiko
Account Number: 1424027224
Bank: Access Bank**

The Office of the Accountant General of the Federation hereby disclaims the activities of these scammers/fraudsters and consequently states as follows:

- i. Promotion arrears are handled by the promotion arrears committee in the Office of the Accountant General of the Federation, not by the Integrated**

Personnel and Payroll Information System (IPPIS) Office.

- ii. Aisha Mustapha is neither a staff nor a Deputy Director (Third Party) IPPIS in the Office of the Accountant General of the Federation.**

- iii. Dr. George, Dr. Francis and Abubakar Kpakiko are not staff of IPPIS in the Office of the Accountant General of the Federation.**

- iv. The above mentioned names are scammers and criminals who are out to dupe the public of their hard-earned money.**

In the light of the foregoing, the public is strongly advised to:

- i. Ignore calls or messages from these fraudsters/scammers to avoid falling prey to their fraudulent activities.**
- ii. Report cases of such fraudulent activities to security agencies.**
- iii. Employees of Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) that are looking for shortcuts to get their salary/promotion arrears paid should be wary of these fraudsters/scammers.**

The Office of the Accountant General of the Federation shall not be liable for the consequences arising from any direct or indirect dealings with these fraudsters/ scammers.
